PT, Dip. MDT

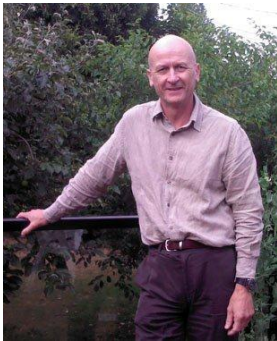
